

The Hot Potatoes Toolbar

- The toolbar can be configured to display all of the menu items as buttons (Options/Toolbar Options).
- Alternatively if you do not display them the items appear as drop down menus.





What is SCORM?

- Sharable Content Object Reference Model (SCORM) is a collection of standards and specifications for webbased e-learning.
- It defines communications between client side content and a host system called the run-time environment.
- It also defines how content may be packaged into a transferable zip file.
