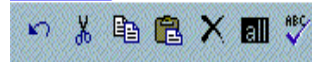
The Hot Potatoes Toolbar

- ❖ Alternatively if you do not display them the items appear as drop down menus.

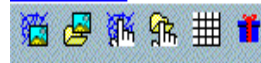

What is SCORM?

- ❖ **Sharable Content Object Reference Model (SCORM)** is a collection of standards and specifications for web-based e-learning.
- ❖ It defines communications between client side content and a host system called the run-time environment.
- ❖ It also defines how content may be packaged into a transferable zip file.
