Using **LIBRARY**SEARCH to find a dissertation or thesis


Introduction

Some dissertations and theses are not kept in the library and so are not found on LibrarySearch. Before you start, have a look at the **dissertations and theses webpage**. From here you can find out whether dissertations for your subject are in the library or kept in a departmental office or elsewhere.

In addition, this page lists some other ways you can search for dissertations and theses.


Getting started

From the **library home page** click on the **LibrarySearch** tab. You can search for any combination of words from the title, author's name or subject.




Look at the **Search Tools** down the left hand side

Under format, select 'thesis/dissertation'. This is listed as a subcategory of 'book'. You will probably need to click on 'show more' under the list of formats to see it.



The results list

In the list of results you can see the titles, authors and years of relevant theses and dissertations.



If you click on the title of any result, you will see more information under 'description'. This may include the name of the course for which the dissertation or thesis was written.

The theses and dissertations held by Oxford Brookes will appear at the top of the results list.
