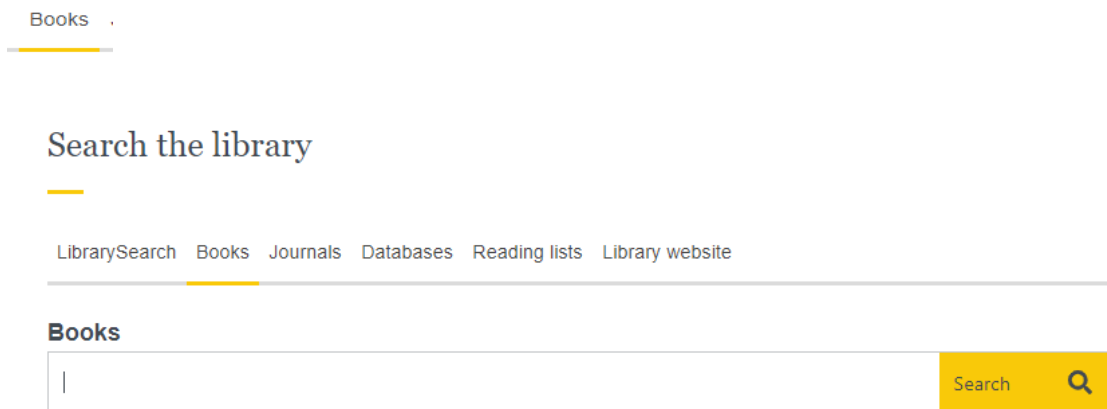

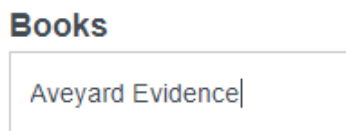

- Scroll down the [Library homepage](#) to the search box and select




- Search for the book by author and part of the title.



You have two ways of finding a journal article.

1. If you need to find a *specific* journal article, such as one that is on a reading list
