If the host has chosen to display the attendees pod you will see a list of people who have logged into the Adobe Connect room. You can see from the example on the left that the pod is divided into three sections – **Hosts**, **Presenters** and **Participants**.

Hosts can promote participants from within the attendees pod. If they have done this you will appear under the Presenters (or Hosts) section of the pod rather than the Participants section.

You can switch view in the attendees pod by clicking on the **Attendee Status View** button at the top left of the pod. This will show who has raised their hand (for example) and how many times. We recommend that you choose the **Attendee View** (which is the

default view) as this gives you more functionality.

You will see that each attendee has a yellow or blue icon next to their name. Yellow icons are logged in attendees (i.e. those who have accessed the room through Moodle) and blue icons are guest attendees (i.e. those who have accessed the room via a URL). Hosts are holding microphones and presenters have presentation screens behind them a or and presenters have presentation screens behind them a or an extended or and presenters have mobile devices and presenters have mobile devices in front of them are or a screen also be yellow if they are logged in.
