

Finding Research and analysis in ThomsonONE

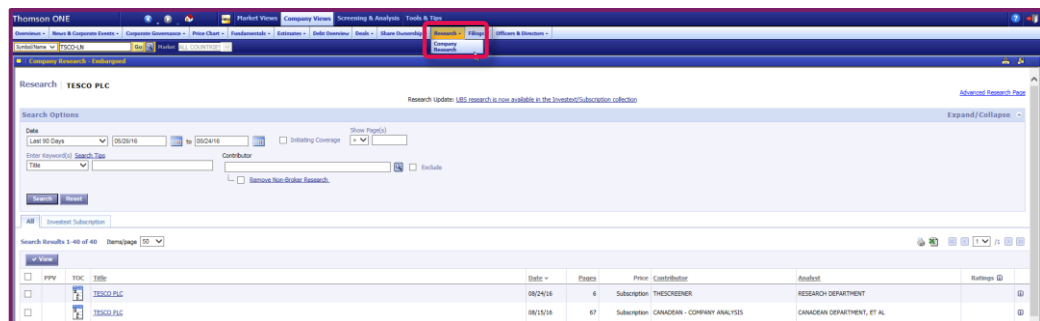
ThomsonONE only works in **Internet Explorer**, it does not work in Chrome or Firefox.

This guide shows you how to find research on companies and industries from leading banks, investment analysts and stockbrokers in ThomsonONE.

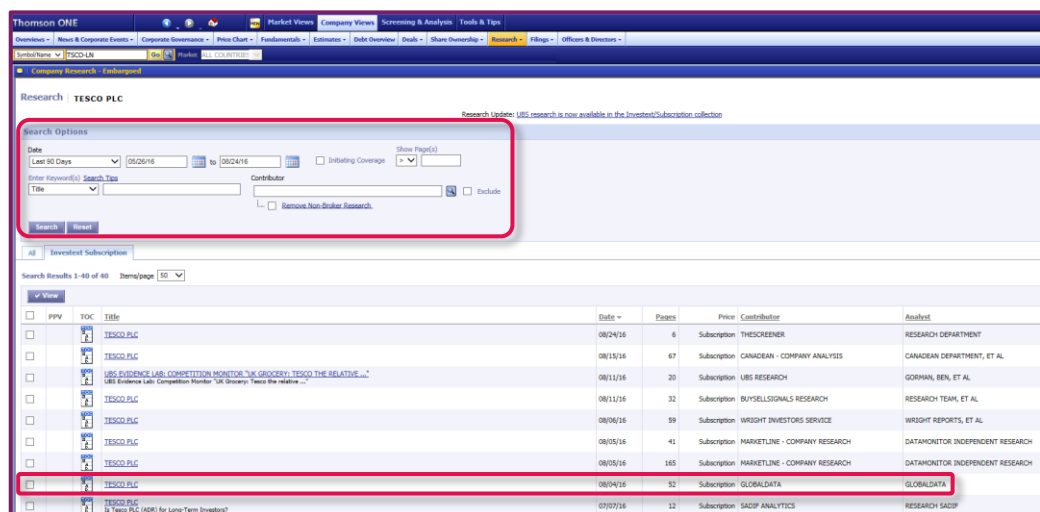
- 1 Click on **Research** at the top of the screen, and then **Company Research**.



- 2 A list of reports for Tesco is displayed from the Investext database.

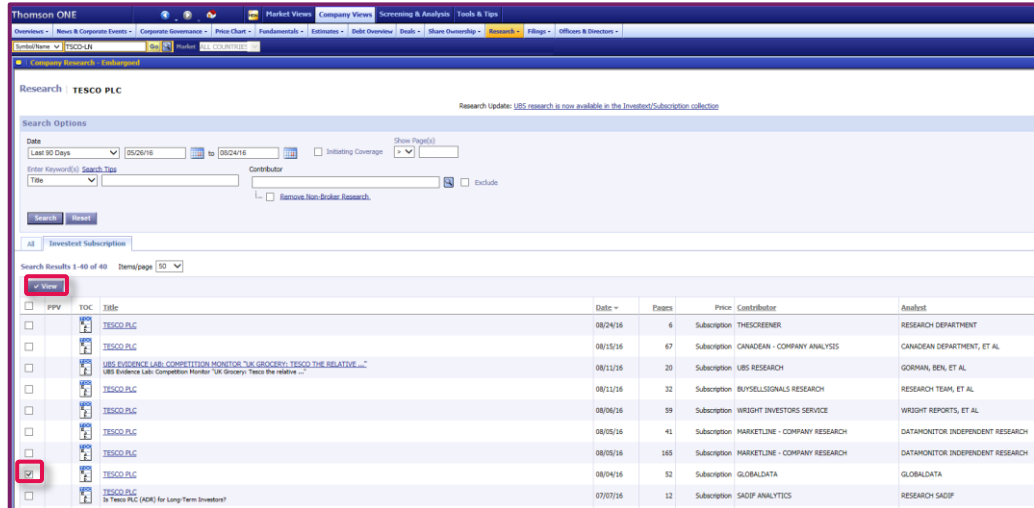
Reports by **GlobalData** are good sources to use in your work, in this example we will find the report released by GlobalData on 08/04/16 (Note that ThomsonONE uses the American date format, so this date is the 4th of August 2016).

To find this specific report, you may need to use the **Search Options** at the top of the screen.



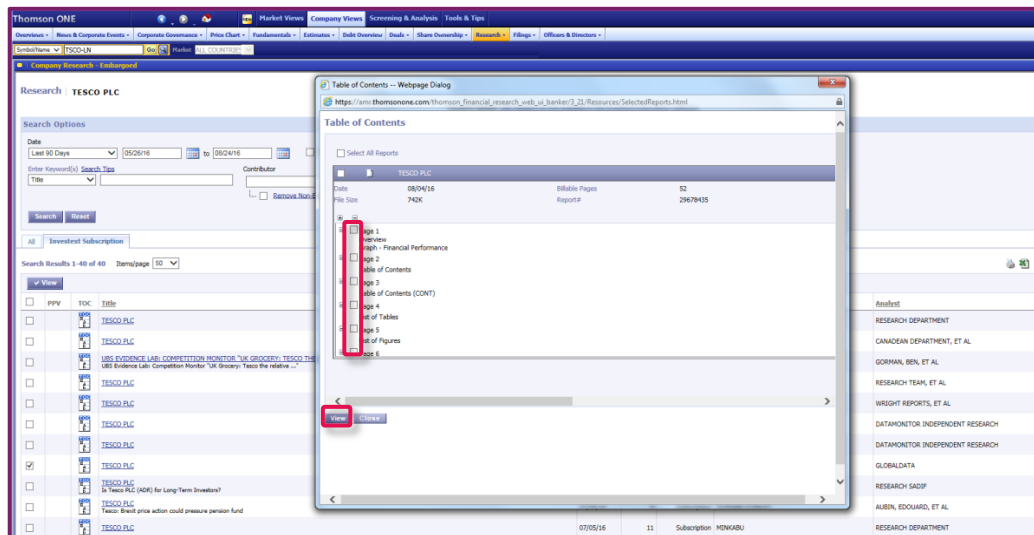
3 Click on the report title to see the contents list.

Tick the box next to **Tesco PLC** then click the **View** button at the top of the list to open the complete report.

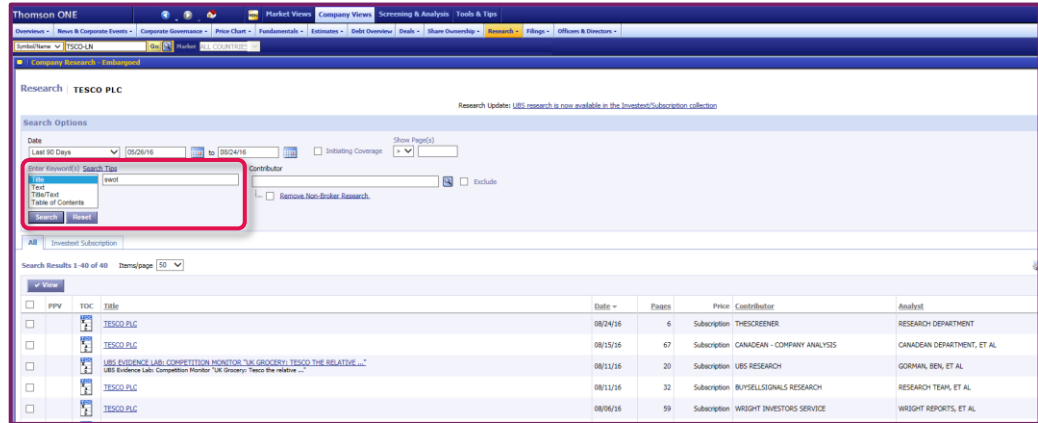


4 The report will appear as a pop-up, tick the sections you would like to view, then click **View**.

You may get a message saying a pop-up has been blocked. Select the option to always allow pop-ups and then repeat your search by clicking on **Research** and go back to step 1. We apologise if you encounter this problem, we are working with OBIS to find a solution.



- 5 You can also restrict your search for reports containing specific information on a company, such as a SWOT analysis. Under **Search Options** enter a keyword(s) and select from either the title, text or table of contents using the drop down list. Click on **Search**.



- 6 You could also try looking for company reports using other criteria, such as industry or geography, by clicking on **Advanced Research Page** in the top right hand corner of the screen and entering your selections under **More Options**. Click on **Search** to display your results.
