

RULES OF THE BOOKER PRIZE FOR FICTION

CLAUSE 2a

Any full length novel, written in English by a citizen of the British Commonwealth, Eire and South Africa, is eligible.

Such a book must be a single work of not less than 50,000 words. *A book of short stories is not eligible.* It must be published, or scheduled for publication, in the United Kingdom between 31st July and 15th November 1972 by a United Kingdom publisher (but pay particular attention to 3 below).
