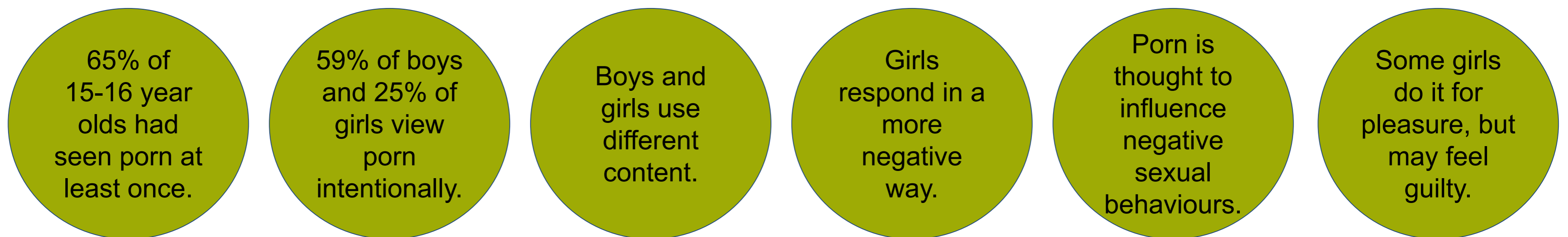


# Young women's engagement with pornography; an investigation of culturally embedded and embodied sexual practice.

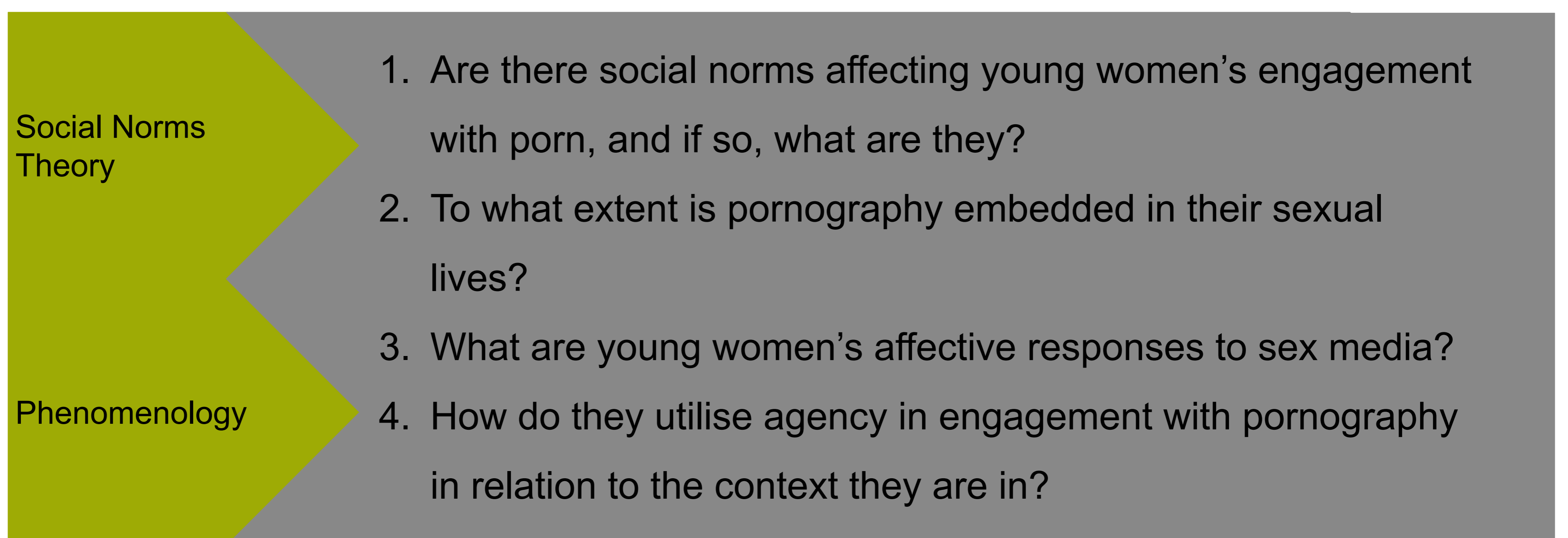
Context



Engagement with pornography is complex, ambiguous, individual and context dependent.

## Research Questions

## Method

Semi-structured online **interviews** with open ended questions aiming to understand the participants' stories.

## Sample

- 2 groups of friends (8-10 individuals)
- Heterosexual
- Cis-**female**
- Aged 16-19

## Analysis

Reflexive **Thematic Analysis** will be used deductively by applying Social Norms theory and inductively in interpretation of data.

Aims

**1.** To contribute to the debate about pornography.

**2.** To inform more effective education programs.
