Passport (formerly Euromonitor) is a database containing reports and statistics on markets, products and industries. You can use it to find information about international companies.

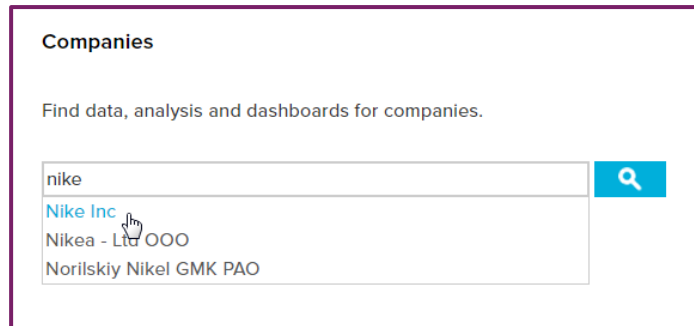
Connect to **Passport** through the Moodle database course or the [library website](#).

At the top of the homepage, choose 'Companies'.

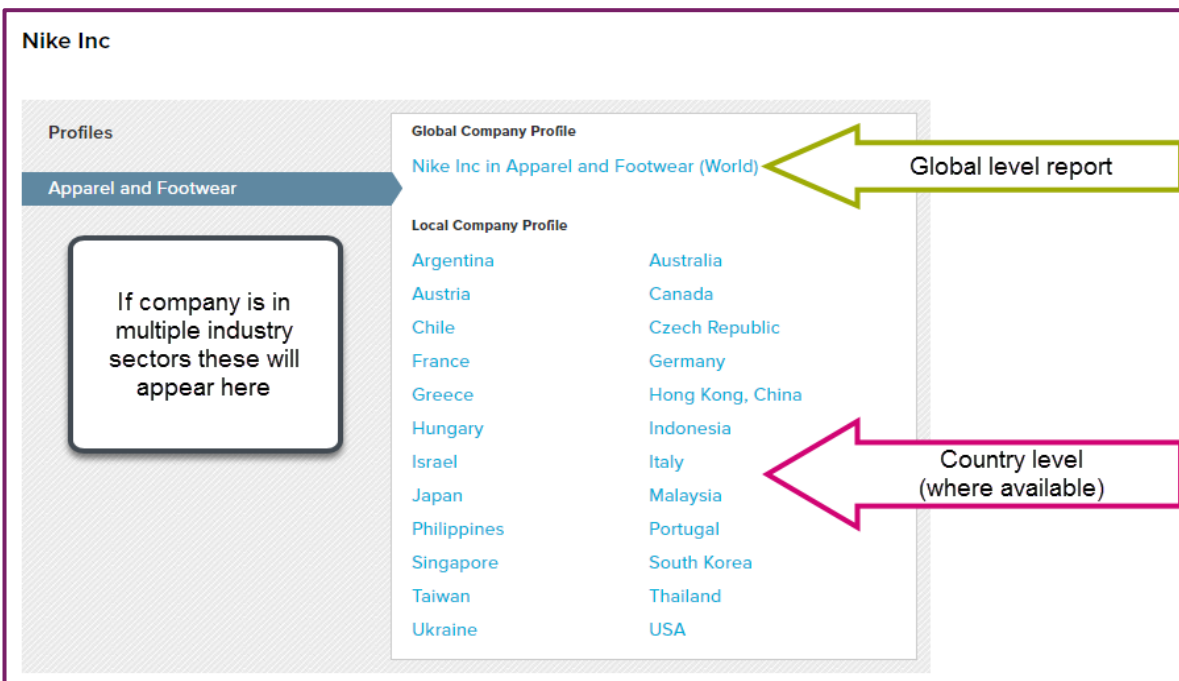


Type a company name into the box that appears.
