I have pleasure in enclosing an entry form, set of rules, and details of the judges for the current prize. There are two new rules to be taken note of, 3 (b) and 4 (ii). The latter will ultimately affect only those publishers whose books reach the short-list; the former is designed to help publishers who feel that certain eligible books on their list, other than their two official entries, should be brought to the attention of the judges. Although clearly stated in the rules, I would like to stress that this has to be done through this office and that none of the judges may be approached direct.
