This document focuses on navigating within Mintel reports.

Start by searching for a topic. You can filter to 'reports' to find detailed analysis of particular markets (see Searching Mintel guide).

Click on the title of a report to open it and view the summary screen.

Searching within reports

From the report summary screen, you can click 'Search this report' to look for specific words or phrases that may be mentioned within the report.



For example, we can search for mentions of 'Deliveroo' in this report.

This will reveal links to all the sections of the report where your search term is mentioned.

When you click one of these, mentions of your search term are highlighted as you read that section.


The interactive databook

On the search summary screen, you can find a link to the interactive databook.

The interactive databook has graphs and tables of the survey data the report is based on.

A screen will appear asking if you want to log in. You do not need to log in to view the databook, so you can click 'Continue without logging in'.


One in the databook, you can use the dropdown menu at the top to select different questions and view the responses.



For example, we can select 'Factors influencing pizza or Italian choice' to see a bar chart of survey respondents' top listed factors.

You can download the data using the options on the right-hand side above the graph.

You can also see the data in different formats, i.e. tables or graphs, and change the way the data is presented, for example as percentages or as a count. These options are located underneath the dropdown menu at the top.



Finally, you can 'explore demographics' to see responses to each question broken down by demographic groups.
