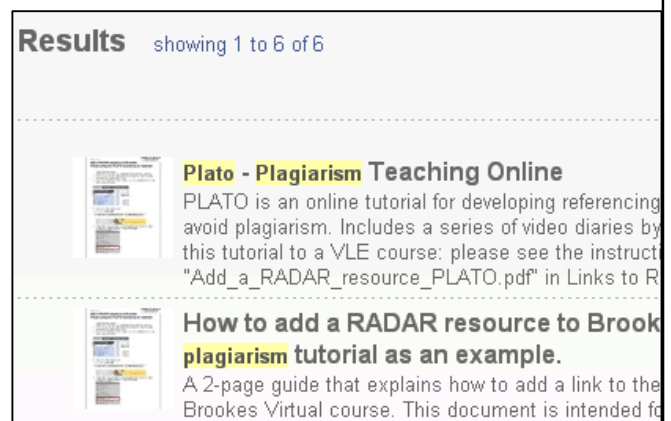
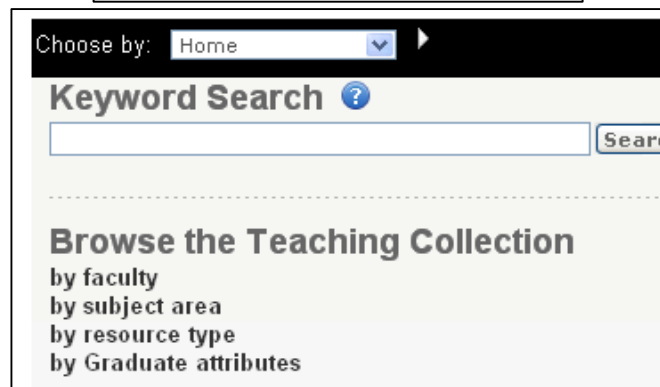
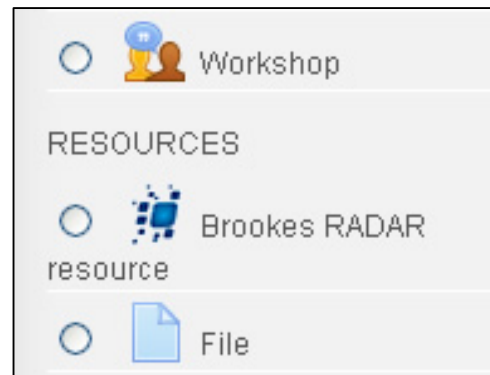



How to Add a RADAR resource to Moodle

- Click on the a resource to display its details.




