How to export a discussion forum

All users can export a single message from a discussion forum by clicking on the **Export to portfolio** link under an individual message. Staff can also export whole discussion forums by clicking on the **Export whole discussion** button that appears for them.

Your data can be exported in HTML or Leap2A portfolio format.



The HTML export creates a standalone web page that can be viewed in most browsers.

The Leap2A export allows you to transfer your data from one Leap2A compliant system to another (e.g. from Moodle to Mahara). The individual files are unreadable outside of a portfolio system.
