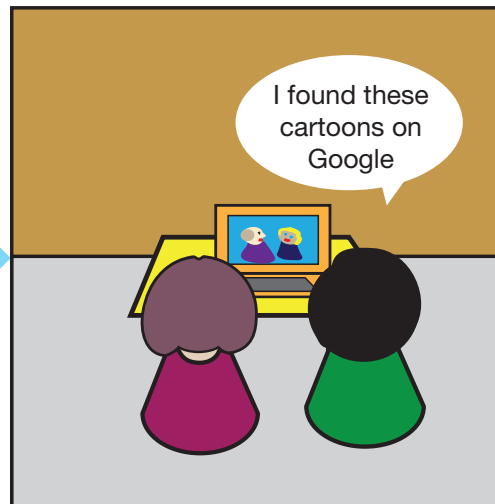


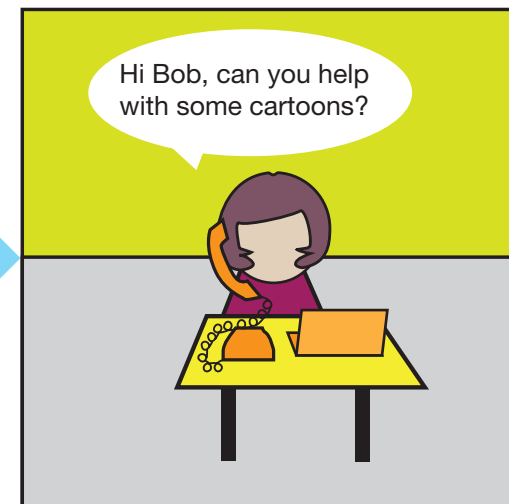
Media Workshop, Graphics - What do we do Cartoon Storyboard



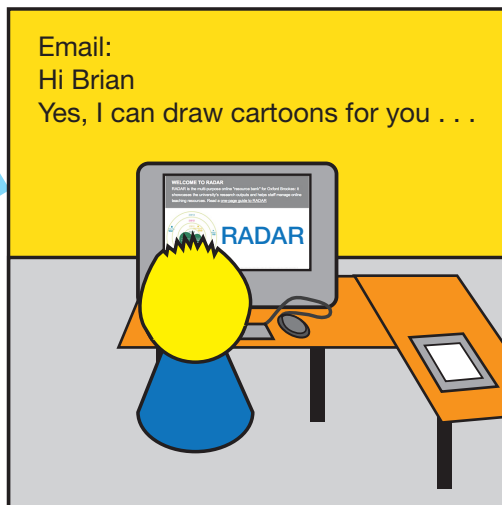
Suzy Lincoln, one of the DMELD's is in a meeting with an academic, Brian Kerry. They want to add a lighter touch to some coursework in Moodle.



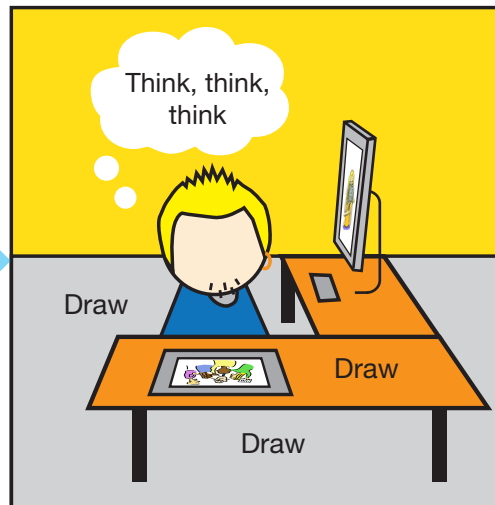
Brian has found some cartoons online but, Suzy thinks they may infringe the copyright laws if they use them.



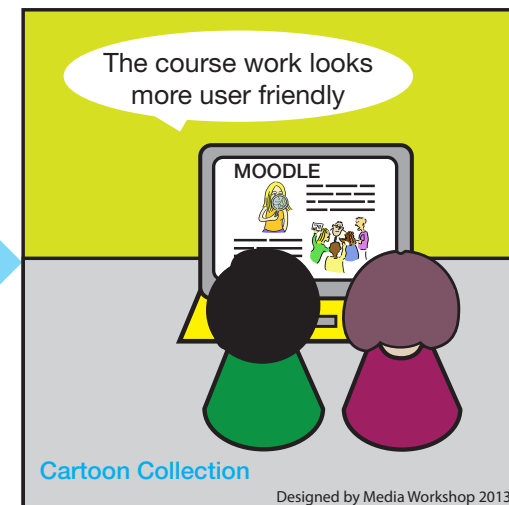
Suzy knows she can go to Bob in the Media Workshop for help.
