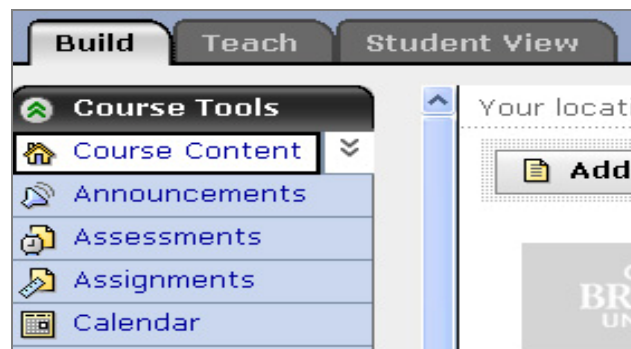


How to Add the Turnitin originality report presentation to a Brookes Virtual course

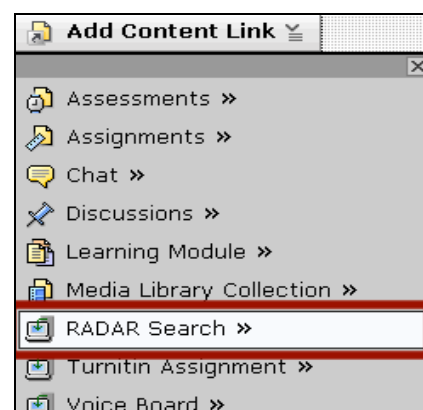
1. Log into Brookes Virtual:
<http://www.brookes.ac.uk/mediaworkshop/vle-gateway>
2. From the **Course List**, click on the course you want to add the resource to.
3. Click **Build** tab. From the **Course Tools** menu on the left-hand side, click on **Course Content**.



4. Click **Add Content Link**.



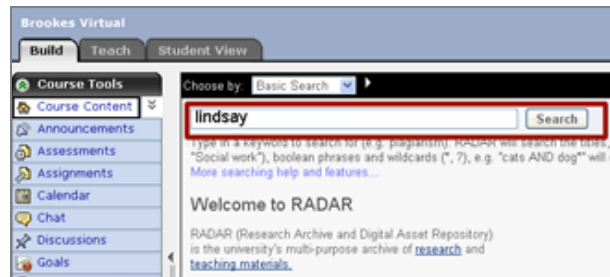
5. From the drop-down menu click **RADAR Search >>**.



6. Click **Create RADAR Search** button.



7. In the main window you will now see a search box at the top. Enter **Lindsay** into the search box and click **Search**.



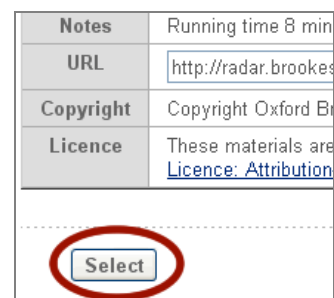
8. The Turnitin presentation '*How to interpret your Turnitin report*' should be the first item in your results list. Click on the item.



9. A summary page providing information about the presentation will now be displayed (see right).



10. Scroll down to the bottom of the page and click **select**.



11. A link to the presentation has now been added to your VLE course. You can test the link by clicking on the **Teach** tab.
