


## A-Z Quick Guide to the Library

Adjustable height tables	It is possible to adjust the height on some tables in the library: ask at the Welcome Desk on Level 1 for more information.
Borrowing & Returns	Students may borrow up to 20 books or other items, using your student card on self-issue machines. The limit is 30 for final year undergraduates, postgraduates, researchers and staff. Books are renewed automatically unless reserved. They must be returned via the return slots next to the Welcome Desk on Level 1.
Course resource help	For in depth subject help, consult the Course Resource Help pages on the Library website - or ask at the Welcome Desk, Level 1.
Dissertations and theses	Please ask at the Welcome Desk, Level 1.
Examination papers	The most recent papers are online. Ask at the Welcome Desk, Level 1.
Group study spaces	The Platform (Level 3) offers group study space, including bookable pods. In addition there are 4 Student Presentation Rooms in the Library and bookings for these, and the pods, are made through the Library website.
Holds	You should only place a hold on an item if it is out on loan, is at another Brookes library or you are rarely on campus - it is quicker to find the book you want by going to the shelf and finding it yourself. Books on hold can be collected from Level 1 near the Library Welcome Desk.
Laptop loans	Chromebooks and laptops are available to borrow, free of charge, from self-service lockers located next to Café Central, in the corridor towards Abercrombie, and in Clerici outside room CLC.G11.
Opening hours	The Library is open 24/7 during semester, with access to the JHB Building by Brookes Smartcard after 21.00. Full details of Library opening hours may be found on the Library website.
Personal belongings	Please keep your personal belongings secure when you are in the Library. We strongly advise you not to leave belongings unattended even if you will be away from the desk for a short time.
PC availability	There are PCs available in the Library on levels 2, 3 and 4. More are available in the JHB Teaching Rooms. PCs are also available in the Clerici, Fuller and Gibbs Buildings.
Printing, copying & scanning	UniPrint machines are located in the Library on levels 1, 2 and 4, and in the Forum. For help, ask at the Welcome Desk on Level 1.
Studying in the library	We have a variety of types of study space available. Please be considerate of other users and observe rules about sound levels. Space is always at a premium in the library so please do not 'reserve' spaces, and always take your belongings with you.
Sensory study space	This space has dimmed lighting, fidget objects, bean bags and a yoga mat. Suitable for 1-2 people, book through the Library website. Find this space on level 3.
Wellbeing Zone	A place to take a break and relax, complete with colouring books, a jigsaw and the Wellbeing Book Collection, which has a wide range of books to help you manage life at university. Find this space on level 1.






