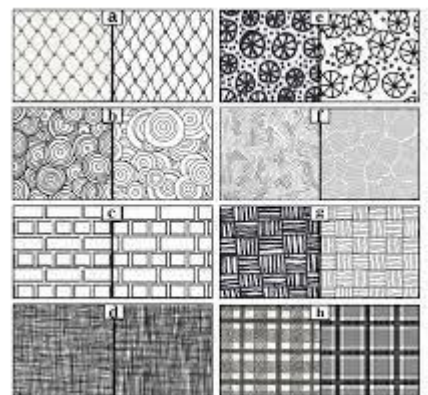




EXAMPLE POEM: THE TYGER BY WILLIAM BLAKE
