

How to get SPSS software for quantitative data analysis

SPSS (produced by IBM) is a statistical package designed to present and analyse quantitative data. The software is available on networked computers across Brookes University. The University's SPSS licence also allows you to install the package on your own computer for free. To do this:

1. Go to the **IT Service Desk** at <https://service.brookes.ac.uk/brookes/> and sign in with your student number and password in the login box.
2. Once logged in, click on the blue box on the left "Browse our service catalogue and make a request".

5. You should then see a list of available downloads, including the latest 2 versions of SPSS. When you have put in your request for the appropriate version, check your Brookes email account.

You will receive 2 emails: A download email with a hyperlink/attachment to download the software; a second email with the serial number and instructions on how to install the software.
